WHAT IS IT LIKE TO STAY at BONNER HOUSE?



We have lots of flats where families stay at Bonner House.



You will not have to share a flat with other families



You might have to share a bedroom with your brother/
sister



You can bring any of your own toys to make your room
feel like your own!



We have a playroom where you can spend time playing
with your parent/carer and at other times some of the
other children who live at Bonner House



You will have a children's worker who will talk to you if
you are worried or want to ask questions.

What do you have at Bonner House?

A LARGE PLAYROOM

We have a big playroom with lots of toys for children of all ages!



LOTS OF TOYS

We have lots of toys, both in your flat and in our playroom but you are welcome to bring any of your own toys along too!



A LARGE PLAYGROUND

Our playground has swings, a climbing frame and plenty of room to run around and have fun



WHO ARE Staff?

You will see a lot of staff during your stay as they help your parent/guardian learn about caring for you.

Staff will spend time with you and your family at different times in the day, this might be when you are:

Eating Meals



**Out of the
centre**



Play Time



What is a sessions?

Sometimes your mum/ dad or carer will have what we call a 'session'.

These are a bit like lessons in school where we talk to your parent/ guardian about what they have learned at Bonner House.



You might sometimes be in one of your parent's or guardian's sessions - these will normally happen in the playroom.

Your Bonner House children's worker will plan some fun sessions for you to attend!



IF I am UNHAPPY ABOUT SOMETHING WHAT SHOULD I DO?

If you are unhappy about anything at all when you're at Bonner House you can...

1. Tell a member of staff

2. Tell the Centre Manager at Bonner House (the Centre Manager is in charge of the staff at Bonner House)

Staff or the Centre Manager will do everything they can to help you!

If you are still unhappy and don't think Bonner House have sorted your problem you can ask staff to use a phone and call Ofsted or The Children's Rights Commissioner

WHERE CAN I GET HELP?



- o Ofsted is an important organisation who makes sure Bonner House keeps children safe who stay here.
- o They come and see Bonner House every 3 years to check they are working with families in the right way
- o Ofsted has said that Bonner House are good at looking after families and keeping children safe

CHILDREN'S RIGHTS COMMISSIONER

The children's right commissioner makes sure that you
are listened to.
