WHAT IS LIKE TO STAY AT DUDLEY LODGE?



We have lots of flats where families stay at Dudley Lodge.



You will not have to share a flat with other families.



You might have to share a bedroom with your brother/ sister.



You can bring any of your own toys to make your room feel like your own!



We have a playroom where you can spend time playing with your parent/carer and at other times some of the other children who live at Dudley Lodge.



You will have a children's worker who will talk to you if you are worried or want to ask questions.

A large playroom

We have a big playroom with lots of toys for children of all ages!

A large playground

Our playground has swings, a climbing frame and plenty of room to run around and have fun!

We have lots of toys both in your flat and in our playroom but you are welcome to bring any of your own toys along too!

WHERE CAN I GET HELP?



- Ofsted is an important organisation who makes sure Dudley Lodge keeps children safe who stay here.
- They come and see Dudley Lodge every 3 years to check they are working with families in the right way.
- Ofsted has said that Dudley Lodge are really good at looking after families and keeping children safe.
