WHAT IS AT BONNER HOUSE?

Bonner House is a bit like school for Moms, Dads, or anyone that looks after us!



We help them learn about keeping you safe.



We help them learn about feeding you nice **healthy food**.



We help them learn about making sure you are clean and have fun bath times!

We help them learn about routines - like when you go to bed.

WHAT IS AT BONNER HOUSE?

Bonner House is a bit like school for Moms, Dads, or anyone that looks after us!



We help them learn about how to show you **love** and **listen** to you.



We help them learn about how to **play** and **talk** to you.



We help them learn about different people in your **family** and how they get on with each other.



We help them learn about money and saving pennies.

WHAT IS LIKE TO STAY AT BONNER HOUSE?



We have lots of flats where families stay at Bonner House.



You will not have to share a flat with other families.



You might have to share a bedroom with your brother/ sister.



You can bring any of your own toys to make your room feel like your own!



We have a playroom where you can spend time playing with your parent/carer and at other times some of the other children who live at Bonner House.



You will have a children's worker who will talk to you if you are worried or want to ask questions.

We have a big playroom with lots of toys for children of all ages!

Our playground has swings, a climbing frame and plenty of room to run around and have fun!
